SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Canossa Academy of Lipa City offers academic scholarship to honor students and non-academic scholarships to the poor but deserving students.

Scholarships are open to both private and public schools within the city of Lipa and other neighboring towns. Scholarship test is scheduled every third Saturday of January. Application forms and scholarship recommendation forms may be secured from the Testing Center.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS:

- I. **ST. JOSEPH SCHOLARSHIP** is awarded to Grade 6 Valedictorians coming from private and public schools and outstanding students graduating students of Canossa Lipa. To qualify, they must:
 - a. pass the qualifying exam
 - b. have a certification from the previous principal that he/she graduated as Valedictorian
 - c. submit certification of good moral character and scholarship recommendation duly signed by the principal and by the guidance counselor/adviser

The scholarship is renewable in the following year if he/she meets the required grade and fulfills the other requirements set by the scholarship committee. The scholarship covers 100% tuition fee.

- II. **ST. ANNE SCHOLARSHIP** is awarded to Grade 6 Salutatorians coming from the private and public schools and to Grade 6 students who belong to the Top Ten with Honors of Canossa Lipa. To qualify, they must:
 - a. pass the qualifying examination
 - b. have a certification form the previous principal that he/she graduated as salutatorian
 - c. submit certification of good moral character and scholarship recommendation duly signed by the principal and by the guidance counselor/adviser

The scholarship covers 50% of tuition fee and renewable in the following year if he/she meets the required grade and fulfills the other requirements.

NON ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

- I. **MAGDALENE OF CANOSSA SCHOLARSHIP** is granted to honor students from poor families who must
 - a. pass the qualifying scholarship exam
 - b. submit a certification of good moral character and scholarship recommendation duly signed by the principal and by the guidance counselor/adviser
 - c. submit a photocopy of the latest Income Tax Return
 - d. belong to social status as verified by the Sister-in-charge through home visitation
 - e. render service on non-class days/summer by accomplishing certain number of hours for the school year
